The requirements of the scholarship are as follows:

- The recipient may use the scholarship funds for tuition and other costs incurred in attending a college or university.
- This is a one-year scholarship. However, a recipient who is not on academic probation and is making satisfactory progress toward completion of a degree may <u>reapply</u> for scholarship renewal. However, priority will be given to new applicants. The student is required to submit a completed application for each year the scholarship is requested.
